**(A)** The Taklimakan Desert, at Asia's heart, keeps an ancient secret. Here, long ago, two great civilizations – the East and the West – made forgotten contact. Here, hints of long-gone life raise the question: was early Chinese culture born alone, or was there a lost link with the West? Silent voices now speak(33): a woman, and others like her up to 4,000 years old, amazingly preserved. Surprisingly, the mummies(34) are clearly not Chinese. They help answer how distant cultures met and exchanged precious(35) goods and ideas.

**(B)** The Silk Road, 6,000 kilometers long, crossed the whole known world. At one end were the great civilizations of Rome and Greece, and at the other, China's borderlands. It was thought that the ruins at the Silk Road's eastern end were Chinese. Now, it seems the builders(37) were a little-known people called Tocharians, who came over 4,000 years ago. The mummies show that people of European origins lived on China's frontier as early as 2,000 B.C.
